The Tulare County Museum is located in Mooney Grove Park in Visalia, California at 27000 S Mooney Blvd, Visalia. The park was established in 1909 and is the oldest county park in the state of California.

The Tulare County Museum houses one of the largest Native American basket collections in California as well as artifacts of the pioneer era, agriculture equipment, restored buildings and many other treasures that tell the history of Tulare County. The newest addition to the museum is the History of Farm Labor and Agriculture Museum, where each cultural group and their contributions to farm labor and agriculture are featured. The museum educates residents of Tulare County as well as visitors on the importance of Tulare County and its history with the hope of recognizing the unique roll it has played in California History.
