This book is about a prophet sent to Nineveh. God's love and concern is for the whole world, not just His chosen people. God proved His love by sending Jesus to save all people—Jews and Gentiles alike.

Jonah

This book from the Minor Prophets told God's people about a messenger God would send. John the Baptist got people ready for a final Messenger—Jesus—who brought good news of salvation.
