

Hello AWANA, Path 56, and Sports Camp Families!

We will be having another AWANA/Path 56 event on Thursday, October 15, 2020. The event will be from 6:30pm – 7:30pm and will be a time to connect, fellowship and be encouraged. There will be worship, an uplifting message, and a pumpkin activity to go along with the message for the evening.

In order to comply with current health mandates and guidelines, please be aware that:

This event will take place outside at the church (please bring your own folding chairs if you are able)

This event is open to our families that were part of AWANA/Path 56 during the last school year or our online Sports Camp over the summer

Parents will need to stay with your children for the entire event

Families will be sitting together, socially distanced from other families by at least 6 feet

Face coverings are optional while outside provided 6 feet of distance can be maintained, but are mandatory if entry into the building is needed (i.e. – restrooms)

If you or anyone in your family is not feeling well, we ask that you stay home even if you have already RSVP'd

We ask that you utilize the hand sanitizer we will have out and practice social distancing of at least 6 feet or more at all times

So that we can best prepare supplies and set up for this event, we would ask for you to RSVP and let us know how many kids and adults in your family will be attending. This can be done by calling or emailing the office. The church will be providing some items for your use in the activity, but you can also bring some things from home if you want.
